Emergent Weed Control

Alligare IMOX Herbicide may be applied for the control of Arrowleaf Elephant Ear (*Xanthosoma sagittifolium*). Alligare IMOX Herbicide is to be applied as a post emergent application.

Terrestrial Use Directions

Alligare IMOX Herbicide can be applied as a foliar spot spray for the control of Arrowleaf Elephant Ear (*Xanthosoma sagittifolium*) with the use of ground equipment in sufficient water to obtain uniform distribution and spray to targeted foliage.

Foliar Spot Application

Apply as a solution containing up to 5% v/v Alligare IMOX Herbicide spray. Add an approved methylated seed oil at 1% v/v. Due to potential recovery from the large corms (underground bulblike structures) retreatment may be necessary. Treatment may be very slow to work, showing limited symptoms for over a month.

DO NOT apply more than 1 pound of imazamox acid equivalent (1 gallon) per acre per year. **DO NOT** exceed 2 applications of Alligare IMOX Herbicide per year. **Minimum Retreatment Interval**: 14 days

Follow all applicable use directions, precautions, and limitations on the product label attached to the Alligare IMOX Herbicide container.
