BROADCAST MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add 34 of the required spray volume to the spray tank and start agitation.
- 2. Add the required amount of Alligare Sonora herbicide.
- 3. Add any surfactants or adjuvants to the spray solution.
- 4. Agitate during the final filling of the spray tank, and maintain sufficient agitation during application, to ensure uniformity of the spray mixture.

NOTE: Do not use grass, hay, straw, or manure from treated areas for 18 months after treatment.
