# **Active Ingredients:**

**Bromacil 80** is powered by the active ingredient bromacil, a Group 5 Uracil herbicide that works as a photosynthesis inhibitor.

## **Use Tips / For Best Results:**

- For best results, Bromacil 80 needs adequate moisture to be incorporated into the soil.
- Bromacil 80 primarily works through root uptake and has limited contact activity on target plants. After weeds have emerged, the addition of a burndown herbicide like Dryphosate 75SG or other common burndown herbicides will improve initial control of target species.
- When tank mixing with Bromacil 80, completely mix the product in the spray tank carrier (water) before adding any other herbicide or spray adjuvant. A small compatibility test should be performed prior to adding the products into the spray tank using a combination of products not previously used.
- Mixing in Water Always follow the W.A.L.E.S. order of mixing. Fill
  Tank half full of water. Start Agitation system and while continuing to
  add water, add Bromacil 80 first followed by additional dry materials,
  then liquids, emulsifiables and finally surfactants.
