GENERAL INFORMATION

ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD is a water-conditioning agent and deposition aid for use with pesticides that are labeled for agricultural, forestry, non-cropland, and right-of-way uses, ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD may be used when the pesticide label recommends the use of ammonium sulfate (AMS) or an ammonium sulfate additive. Hard water cations and high pH can decrease mixability and solubility of certain pesticides, especially Glyphosates, 2.4-D Amines and Garlon salts.

Note: ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD does not replace the need for a crop oil concentrate or nonionic surfactant. For specific rates of a CDC or NIS, always refer to the pesticide manufacturers'

ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD is approved for aquatic use with pesticides labeled for aquatic use.

If the applicator does not have experience using this product, a phytotoxicity and jar test must be performed to facilitate crop safety and tank mix compatibility.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO HERBICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the herbicide being used. The herbicide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label. Generally, use 1-3 quarts per 100 gallons spray solution (0.25-0.75% v/v) for pround and aerial application. For most uses, the recommended rate is 2 quarts per 100 gallons (0.50% v/v). ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD contains the equivalent of 2 pounds AMS per gallon.

MIXING

All spray mixing and application equipment must be thoroughly cleaned before pesticides are applied.

1. Fill spray tank half full of water and start agitation.

- 2. Add desired rate of ALLIGARE WATER CONDITIONER GOLD to water. before adding pesticides.
- Add pesticides as directed by the label, while maintaining agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL INFORMATION

STORAGE: Store product in original container only. Do not allow other chemicals to be introduced into the container. Keep this container closed when not in use. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse container and pour rinsate into soray tank. Do not reuse container. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
