## 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Clean up spills immediately observing the precautions in Section 8 of this SDS. Thoroughly ventilate area and use a NIOSH approved respirator if dusting occurs. Dike spill and prevent material from entering sewers, waterways or low areas. Shovel or sweep up and place material in closed containers for disposal. Do not raise dust.

## 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

## 12. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Chlorsulfuron is moderately mobile in soil at low pH, but very mobile at high pH. Chlorsulfuron can be persistent in the environment. Degradation half-lives vary primary with pH, from a few weeks to over one year in soil at high pH. Due to its solubility in water, chlorsulfuron does not bioaccumulate.
